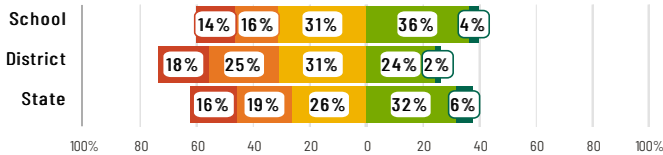

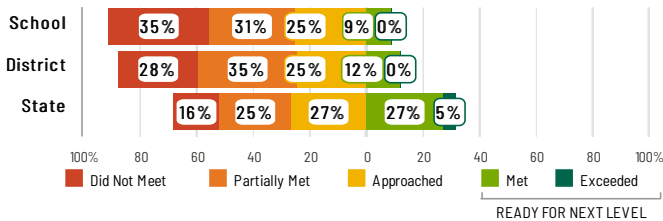
## Academic Success

### English Language Arts



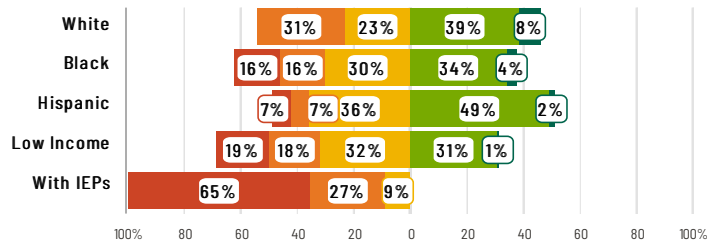

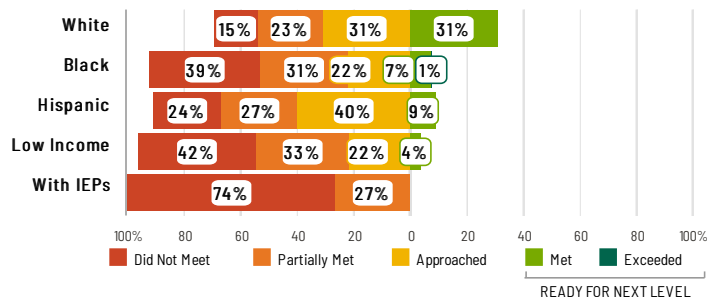
## Success by Student Group

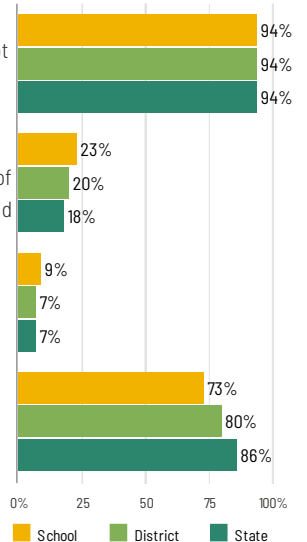

### Academic Courses

### Physical Education, Health and Wellness

At Brookwood Junior High, the Physical Education (PE) and Health programs are designed to promote lifelong fitness, wellness, and informed decision-making. These programs emphasize the importance of physical activity, mental health, and healthy living habits for students' overall well-being.

### Other Programs and Activities

Brookwood Junior High School offers a variety of programs and activities for academic enrichment and student interests. Extracurricular activities play a crucial role in shaping our students' personal, social, and academic development.

### School Awards

Brookwood Jr. high School celebrates student achievements, as they help to foster motivation, and build a positive school culture. These events play a critical role in students' development during a transitional stage of their lives. An Awards Assembly is held every year in May to recognize and celebrate our students accomplishments.

### School Personnel Resources

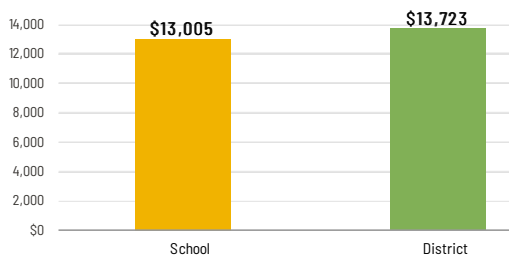
Providing resources for school personnel is essential to fostering a productive, supportive, and inclusive educational environment. These resources empower educators, staff, and administrators to perform their roles effectively while supporting the overall development and success of students.

### Facilities

## School-Level Finance
