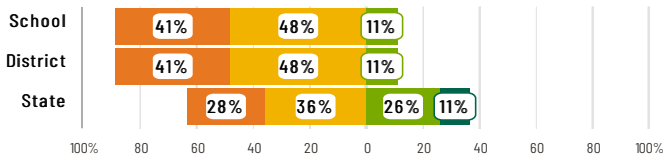

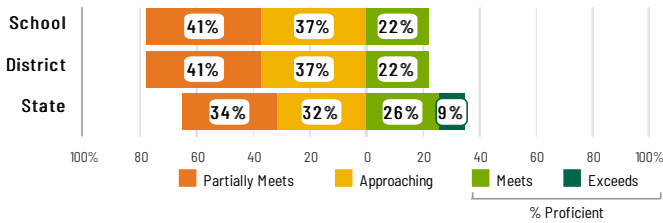

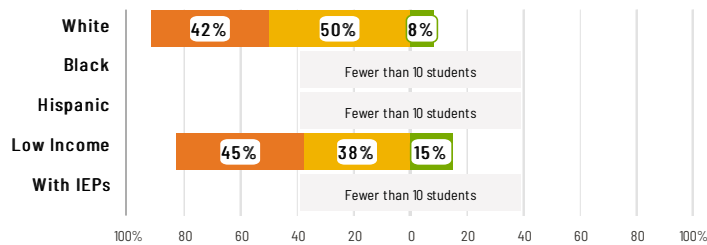

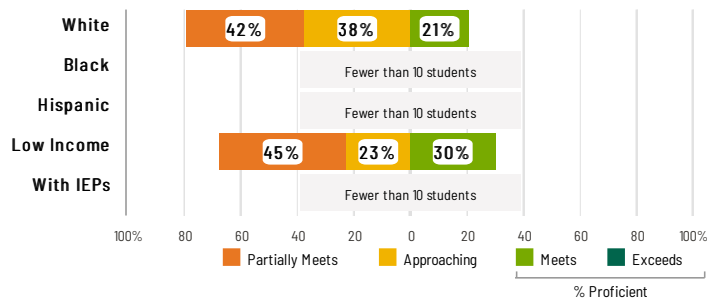
Success by Student Group

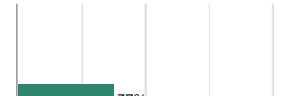

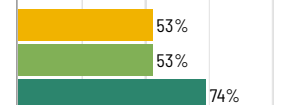
Early College Coursework

Students taking early college coursework in grades 10, 11, and 12



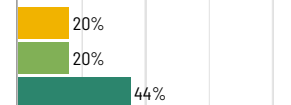
Postsecondary Enrollment

School Highlights

Academic Courses

La Moille High School has expanded course offerings to prepare students for career readiness in today's society. In addition, college preparation is always a strong focus. Our students have the opportunity to build trade skills at Area Career Center located at La Salle-Peru High School. The high school also has a strong partnership with IVCC.

Physical Education, Health and Wellness

Physical Education is required for all four years at La Moille High School. Students are only allowed to exempt if enrolled in the College and Career Start Programs, including duel credit classes. In this case, junior college fitness classes are required. Physical Education focuses on health and fitness, as well as team building activities design

Other Programs and Activities

La Moille High School has an enthusiastic band and choir program led by Mrs. Alexandra Krug. FFA is an active program earning state honors and is advised by Mr. Ed Melendez. The art department continues to display creativity on several levels and is led by Ms. Dawn Neubaum.

School Awards

La Moille High School recognizes academic success, as well as citizenship and volunteerism through organizations like National Honors Society, Student of the Month recognition and incentive programs. Multiple scholarship opportunities are also available. Community Service Programs are also offered for freshman -seniors.

Career Development Courses and Programs

La Moille High School has developed a Career Start Program providing examination of student interests among career clusters to guide class schedules to meet career requirements. LHS offers a Career Exploration course, STEM activities, Area Career Center courses located at LP High School, and Duel Credit/on campus coursework at Illinois Valley Comm

Athletics

La Moille High School has an existing Co-op with Ohio High School for the following sports and activities: Girls volleyball, basketball, cheer, as well as boys basketball, scholastic bowl and band/drama. LHS also has an existing Co-op with Amboy High School which involves football, wrestling, track and XC. A Co-op with Mendota is being explored.

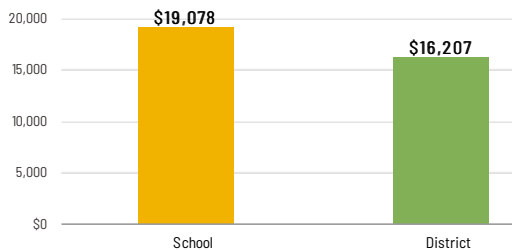
Mrs. Katie Shevokas serves as the high school guidance counselor. Additional services for students as provided through the BMP Cooperative.

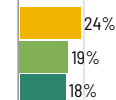
Attendance Rate

Rate at which students are present at school, not including excused or unexcused absences



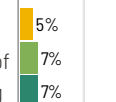
Chronic Absenteeism

Percentage of students who miss 10% or more of school days per year either with or without a valid excuse



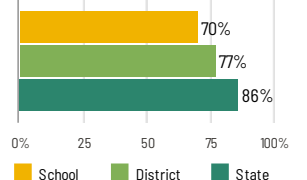
Student Mobility
