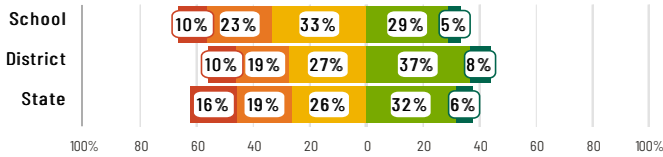

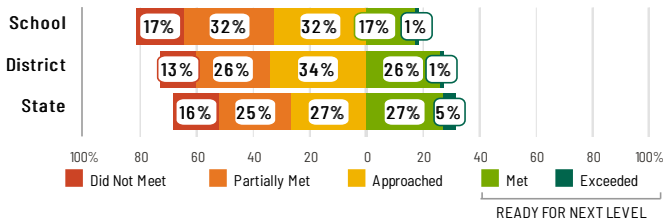
Academic Success

English Language Arts



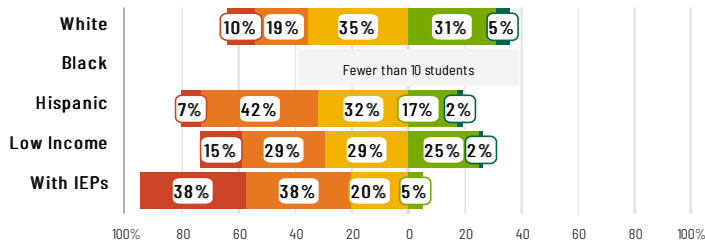

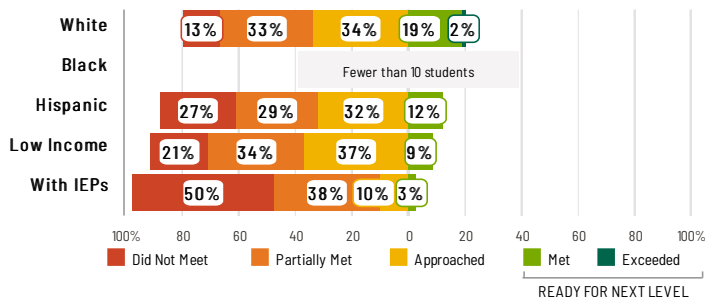
Success by Student Group

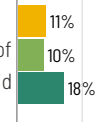
Attendance Rate

Rate at which students are present at school, not including excused or unexcused absences



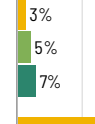
Chronic Absenteeism

Percentage of students who miss 10% or more of school days per year either with or without a valid excuse



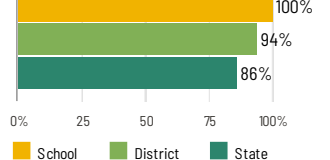
Student Mobility

School Highlights

Academic Courses

Beecher Junior High School offers a comprehensive academic curriculum with coursework in Language Arts, Reading, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies and a pair of year-long elective classes: Band and Chorus. Art, Computers, Health, and Spanish are mandated for 6th & 7th graders. 8th graders have Health but have options along with Keyboarding.

Physical Education, Health and Wellness

Beecher Junior High School offers physical education five days a week. Health is required for all students and is a one-quarter exploratory class. Our Second Step Program is part of our Health curriculum and helps address social emotional health.

Other Programs and Activities

Beecher Junior High School provides other enriching opportunities. This includes Environmental Club, Student Council, Bobcat PRIDE, Scholastic Bowl, Speech team, Math team, and the Spelling team. As part of our curriculum, 7th and 8th grade students have the opportunity to qualify for state in the science fair competition.

School Awards

Beecher Junior High School earned an Illinois State Academic Excellence Award in 2011 and the village of Beecher was awarded the Governor's hometown Award in 2000. 86% of Beecher Junior High Schools certified staff have a masters degree or higher. Academic teams have earned twenty-two conference and four regional championships since 1996.

Career Development Courses and Programs

Beecher Junior High School has attended the 8th grade Career Awareness Day each year sponsored by Kankakee Area Career Center (KACC).

Athletics

Beecher Junior High School's athletic program consists of four boys teams and five girls teams. Students participate in IESA competition at the 7th and 8th grade levels. Athletic teams have earned three state, thirty-one sectional, forty regional, and thirty conference championships since 1996.

Facilities

Beecher Junior High School was first opened in 2007. Inside of the school, we have one gym, cafeteria, large library, 18 classrooms, and a computer lab. We have two science labs, which we use as classrooms and a band room with multiple practice rooms. Outside of the school, we have a soccer field and access to 4 small ballfield areas.

School-Level Finance
